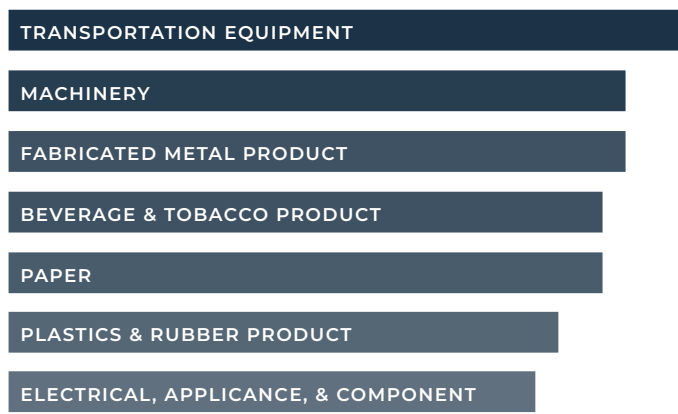


ADVANCED MANUFACTURING
