WS/FCS seeks to create safe and successful experiences for volunteers. Part of that experience includes the volunteer's safety and welfare while on a WS/FCS campus. Throughout the year, schools perform various safety drills to practice emergency procedures for situations related to fire, severe weather, and lockdown situations. Staff also go through training on procedures for an active shooter situation. Practices, protocols, and trainings are facilitated through the WS/FCS Office of Safety, Security, and Emergency Management. In the event of a safety drill or an emergency situation while on a campus, volunteers should follow the directions of school staff on how to respond appropriately to an incident on a WS/FCS campus.
