Core Responsibilities

1. Member Engagement & Retention

A primary goal for our Ambassadors is to enhance member satisfaction and drive retention through proactive engagement.

- Personalized Outreach: Regularly call or visit existing members to gauge their

- Meeting Attendance: Commit to attending a minimum of four (4) Ambassador Committee Meetings annually. (Meetings held bi-monthly)
- **Networking & Introductions:** Actively engage with attendees at events, make member-to-member introductions, and help facilitate valuable connections.
- **Brand Advocacy:** Positively represent GWSI at all times. Utilize provided GWSI collateral, maintain confidentiality regarding internal committee discussions, and act as a positive extension of the organization in the community.

3. Membership Growth & Support

Support the growth of GWSI by identifying prospects and assisting with their integration.

- Prospective Member Referrals: Identify and refer prospective members to GWSI staff.
- **New Representative Integration:** Guide and support new representatives of existing member companies as they navigate their initial involvement with GWSI.

- Commit to one year of volunteer service.
- Adhere to GWSI's code of conduct and confidentiality guidelines.
